Who do we collect personal data from?

Climate Action Ilkley collects personal information from people requesting newsletters, members, people who donate and other contacts.

What data do we collect?

We collect name, email address and postcode. In addition we occasionally ask members for their views on initiatives that we plan to undertake.

How do we use your data?

email address	we use it to send newsletters and keep you up-to-date with our meetings, events and activities.
Name	we ask members for their name in order to keep a register of members
Postcode	In certain transport related projects we use it to know what area our members and newsletter readers live in

Who do we share your data with?

We do not share your data within any other organisation other than those service companies we use to communicate with you. Currently they are:

Mailchimp	we use them to send out our email communications
Slack	This is a team collaboration tool and we use it to communicate within workgroups and project teams
Eventbrite	We use them to register attendees of meetings and events

Your Rights

You have the right to ask us, in writing, for a copy of all the personal data held about you. (This is known as a "subject access request"). You should write to:-
